## **GAME PREVIEW:** For the second week in succession, it will be two multiple defending state champions clashing when St. Edward hosts Boyle County, Kentucky

After a victory against a two-time defending state champion, St. Joe's Prep, Philadelphia, now the Eagles get another big challenge in Boyle County, Kentucky.

Boyle County has won the state championship in Kentucky the last four years and is currently ranked No. 1 in the state. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m. Saturday inside First Federal Lakewood Stadium.

"They have a lot of talent and a great culture and tradition," St. Edward Head Coach Tom Lombardo said. They're ready to play, and they have great athletes."

The Rebels are led by Montavin Quisenberry, a West Virginia commit.

Quisenberry, (No. 5), is considered the best player in the state. He plays a slot back and sometimes running back. The Rebels (2-0) do a variety of plays, using him.

"They give him the ball from different formations," Coach Lombardo said. "He's super explosive." The Rebels have a couple tight ends who are Division I prospects. (No. 6), Geo Brown, is a wide receiver. Demauriah Brown, (No. 0), is a Division I safety.

"Demauriah Brown is good and Geo is superfast," Coach Lombardo said. "They're definitely athletic." Both play wide receiver.

Up front, the Rebels have some size, but that isn't everything.

"They have a couple big guys," Coach Lombardo said. but they are really solid. They carry out their assignments. They run a unique offense that is sharp. A lot of misdirection."

This season Boyle County has defeated Lexington Christian, 35-13, and Bryan Station, 48-8.

For the Eagles (2-0), the turnover ratio went from 0-4 to 2-0 over the first two games.

"We made some improvements," the coach said. "The previous week, we had some turnovers, but one was late in the game and another one was on fourth down. It didn't look good, but four turnovers are four turnovers. Sometimes we have to throw the ball on fourth down. We had one bad turnover in the game (against Pickerington North in Week One). We've been correcting that."

St. Joe's was connecting on its third-down plays in the second half, but the Eagles sputtered some.

"They converted on third downs and scored from the red zone," Lombardo said. "We didn't. We had a little lull there after the first drive of the third quarter. I think we went three-and-out a couple times."

Yes, but they weren't doing anything wrong; they were just facing a championship team.

"We have to take into account the opponent," Coach said. "I thought they were pretty good."

The team knows it is a new week every week and the goal is to go 1-0 this week.

"I told the kids in the team meeting, we can't really rest on our laurels and take a breath," Coach Lombardo said. "For every one of our teams, if we are not playing well, we can lose. We won those two; those two and anyone else in the future on our schedule could beat us."

Truly, a good portion of the game is mental.

"We have to take that one-week-at-a-time-mentality," Lombardo concluded. "We have to practice and keep getting better. We need to play the game on the day it's scheduled and stay healthy."

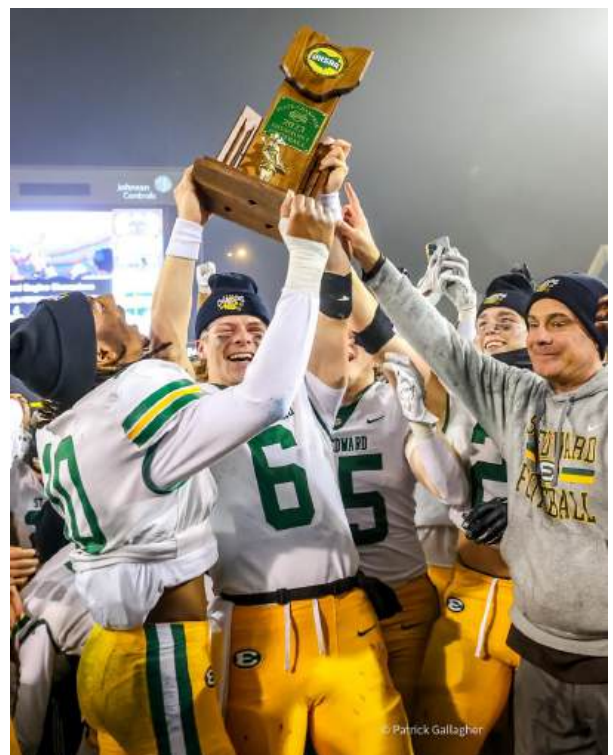

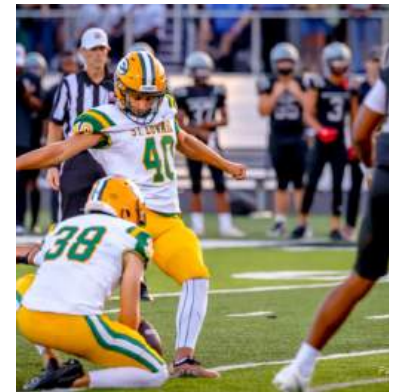
