GAME PREVIEW: More shifting, and motioning, unbalancing, realigning, trickery when St. Edward varsity football faces undefeated Elder By Norm Weber

Looking to bounce back from a loss to Boyle County, KY, St. Edward's defense will be challenged with more of the same by Elder, which has similar tricks the Eagles saw this past weekend.

This weekend's football game pits St. Edward against Elder at 2 pm Saturday inside First Federal Lakewood Stadium.

Elder (3-0) mirrors Boyle County (3-0) on offense with a bunch of razzle-dazzle going on all the time. "A lot of motion, a lot of shifting, unbalanced sets, different or exotic formations that mostly create problems," St. Edward Head Coach Tom Lombardo said. "This team (Boyle) certainly did that."

The Eagles (2-1) at least have a history with Elder that they have better collected knowledge that they know what they can do.

"We have to make some corrections, obviously. We have to work on doing the things we didn't do like blocking and tackling," the coach said. "These are things you are going to have problems with. They came in with some new things that we had to make quick adjustments to. We have no history with them. Give credit to them for sure."

The impetus was No 5, (Montavin) Quisenberry. "He threw it, he ran it, he caught it. He did it all. What a super player he is. He played defense and returned kicks."

Quisenberry had 141 yards rushing, 89 yards passing and 35 yards receiving for a total offense mark of 265 yards.

"Elder is solid," Lombardo said. "They don't get beat deep very often on defense. They give you a lot of schemes on offense."

Like Boyle, a lot of players get involved in the offensive skills positions.

"Then on offense they use their personnel wisely," Coach Lombardo said. "They've been doing it for a long time and they do things well. They do a good job of using their guys in different positions to make plays."

St. Ed's played Boyle evenly in the first half, matching the Rebels TD for TD. The turning point arrived after the second half kickoff. The Eagles could have taken the lead for the first time, but were forced to kick the first and only punt of the game.

"We went down and drove down deep from that first play," Lombardo said. "We had a couple of bad plays, incomplete passes and we had fourth and 14. We were with the wind and we could try a field goal. Do we punt from the 38? Brandon (White) got hurt and then they throw a touchdown the next play. We could have had two scores then. We didn't and those are things we need to work on."

Three teams are undefeated in the Greater Catholic League and Elder is one of them.

The Panthers beat Springboro, 38-6, last week. Joey Thamann leads the league in rushing with 242 yards.

Elder has quite a group of defenders. George Guidugli leads the leauge in tackles. Matthew Golinar, Derek Uran, and Maddox Arnold are the top three sack men in the league.




