**GAME PREVIEW** For the first time in the last five meetings, St. Edward and Massillon will play a varsity football game in Lakewood

LAKESWOOD – Massillon High School has finally agreed to play St. Edward here inside First Federal Lakewood Stadium.

Kickoff time between the varsity Eagles and the Tigers is set for 7 p.m. Friday.

Typically, Massillon insists on home games due to the fact that 5-8,000 people would travel to anywhere the Tigers are playing – with one caveat: a stadium large enough would be needed to accommodate these fans. FFLS is large enough to hold close to 10,000 when including the lawn seats on the hill in the south end zone.

“After we had gone down there four years in a row, their coming to Cleveland is not asking too much,” St. Edward Head Coach Tom Lombardo said.

The Eagles have played inside Paul Brown Stadium against the Tigers seven times. Massillon has come here once and once they met at a neutral site.

The Eagles (3-1) are familiar with Tigers’ quarterback Jalen Slaughter. He’s completed 69-of-108 pass attempts for 859 yards and seven touchdowns.

Slaughter was a starter two years ago as a sophomore and threw a TD pass on fourth down with 11 seconds to go to defeat the Eagles. The Tigers had new life when the Eagles were running out the clock and turned over the ball.

“They have electric receivers, good physical fast backs, and then they have Slaughter who is an experienced quarterback firing around the ball back there,” Coach Lombardo said. “They’re formidable on offense with their speed.”

Braylen Toles has caught 18 of those for 139 yards.

Jacques Carter has snared in 12 passes for 232 yards. It doesn’t stop there. Ricardo Wells has caught 11 for 183 yards. Ja’Meir Gamble has also caught 11.

“All of them can beat you,” Lombardo said.

Gamble is also the running back, garnering 338 yards and a 7.7 average.

“They pass a lot, but the last game they broke a couple decent touchdown runs,” the coach said. “They want to be balanced. They have a good line. Their left tackle is going to Wisconsin. They can and have used some of their defensive linemen in the backfield before. We might see a little of that since they did it in the last game.

“When they have those explosive receivers, I can see why they pass more than they run.”

Defensively, Jayden Williams leads with 32 tackles and a forced fumble. The Tigers (2-1) also have Mylen Lenix who has 23 tackles including 3.5 for losses and a fumble recovery.

Also watch out for Tra’Yon Williams, who has 20 tackles, and interception and a forced fumble.

Tyler Hackenbracht has 20 tackles and a pass break up. Lennox Lemon is another threat. He has two interceptions for 63 yards.

The Eagles are going into this game, building off last week’s win against Elder.

“I don’t see much in the home field advantage except the travel, but we’ve gone down there a couple times and have won,” the coach said. “They won two close ones when we went down there. They were two good teams that beat us the last two years.”

The confidence level continues to build and that could be a starting point for an advantage piece.

“It’s what your strengths and weaknesses are,” Lombardo said. “The opponents don’t know much about you. You win on experience and emotion. Teams win without understanding themselves. After a couple games you find your niche. Once you start doing something, that never leaves. People get that film and can say this is their strong end, this their weak end, this is what we have to stop. Things are balancing out with teams knowing one another decently. It’s who plays better that night and who executes better.”

Last week’s game was a back-and-forth game as was the game of two weeks ago for one half.

“When you play those kinds of teams (top five in the state), you are going to be in close games,” Coach said.

“They are all good teams, they are all going to go back and forth and they are going to come down to the end.

You just hope you play well enough to win.”

In Drew Pasteur’s Fantastic 50, four of the top six teams ranked in the state are on St. Edward’s schedule. One of the other two is St. Ed’s, which is ranked No. 1.

The talent and schedule parlayed the Tigers into Division II state champions. It was their first ever since the playoffs began 52 years ago. Massillon won 24 state champions from the early 1900s to 1970 when the champion was determined by poll.

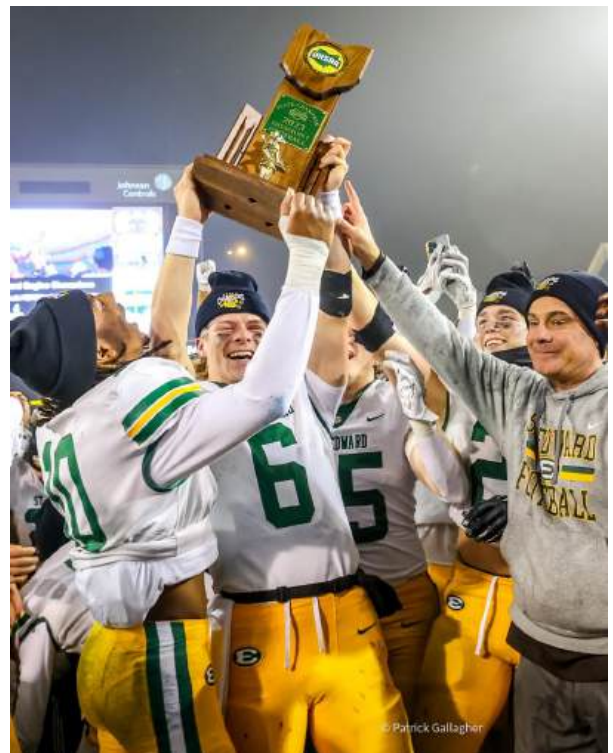

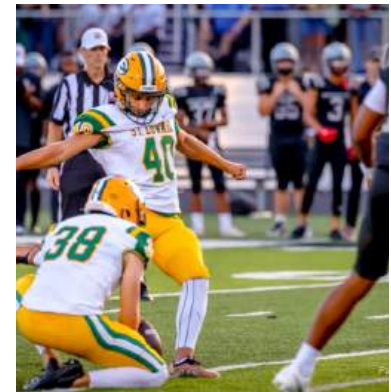
