GAME PREVIEW : St. Edward gets its fourth defending state champion in six weeks, Glenville, D-IV state champs, to face Eagles in Berea, Eagles looking for more consistency

LAKEWOOD – Another state champion team awaits St. Edward football, the fourth in six weeks, when the Eagles take on Glenville at 7 pm Thursday on Tressel Field inside the George Finnie Stadium at Baldwin Wallace University.

St. Ed's (3-2), the three-time defending big-school state champion, is 1-2 against state champion teams so far this season.

Glenville, once a formidable Division I program, has shrunk in numbers, but the football program has not. Division IV suits the Tarblooders well considering they have won back-to-back state championships.

Glenville has a strong defense led by linebacker Sincere Johnson, and in fact their entire linebacker corps plays tough football.

"They are an excellent team that is very athletic," said St. Edward Head Coach Tom Lombardo.

The Eagles scrimmaged the Tarblooders in October and won.

"Their quarterback is up-and-coming," Coach Tom Lombardo said. "They are a much improved team from where they were in the scrimmage."

Combine that with the tradition they have had all along with Ted Ginn, Sr. as the head coach and they become challenging against bigger schools including Avon, Liberty and Upper Arlington, the latter of which they beat.

"The running back returns from last year when he was a safety," Coach Lombardo said. "They have a good secondary and a strong offensive line. They are up-and-coming. They are definitely going to make some noise. They make the playoffs every year."

The Eagles' offense sputtered a little in the last game especially on fourth-down plays.

"They are solid (on defense)," Coach said. "Their defensive line is physical. They get off the ball and have some solid defensive ends. They have some guys interiorly at the defensive tackle position. The other linebacker is excellent, too. He mirrors Sincere Johnson much so that it is hard to tell them apart."

Fourth down was not friendly to the Eagles this past week. They turned the ball over on downs three times including fourth-and-one plays. They had a botched punt and field-goal attempt.

"Obviously, getting those yards on fourth-down plays was a failure," the coach said. "The thing is consistency. It's funny. This week we couldn't get two yards when we needed it. In week four we had over 240 yards rushing. This week we ran it for 60 or 70 yards. We're capable; we are just not consistent. We have to find what we need to do, but once we find the consistency, we will improve quickly. It's really more in spurts instead of consistence." While the running game isn't what it was in week four, the passing game was consistent in week five.

Thomas Csanyi threw for 251 yards including three touchdowns.

"Thomas played a really good game; he was efficient the whole game, which was really good," Lombardo said. "He had the numbers and the receivers caught some good passes. Luke Hess made some good catches. The linemen protected him well. We did improve on that. If we put it all together, that's what we are looking for. We are learning on the job, per se."

The Glenville game was originally scheduled for Saturday inside First Federal Lakewood Stadium, but a band concert pushed it to Finnie and on Saturday, and then a TV deal moved it to Thursday."

"Rock Entertainment wanted to do something special and add to what they do, which is Friday nights and Saturdays," Coach Lombardo said. "We'll get more students to the game than we would not normally would have had. I think it is a good idea. It's fun playing at night. I think it will be cool."

TWO LOSS SEASONS:

Its been rarity since 2010 that the Eagles have two regular season losses. Prior to this year the Eagles lost more than 2 games was 2018. That year they went on to win a state title.

2009 was the last sub .500 year at 4-6. That marks 15 consecutive winning seasons and 7 state titles.

WELCOME BACK:

The Eagles are playing this week's "home" game at Tressel Field at Finnie Stadium for the first time since 2019.

That year they hosted Medina in a first round playoff game.

From 1980 to 1988 St. Ed's played their home games on the turf at Baldwin Wallace University.

200 YARDS PASSING:

Thomas Csayni's 244 passing yards was the first 200 yard plus game for an Eagle QB since week seven in 2023.

Casey Bullock threw for 257 yards and was the only game for more than 200 yards passing yards by the Eagles.

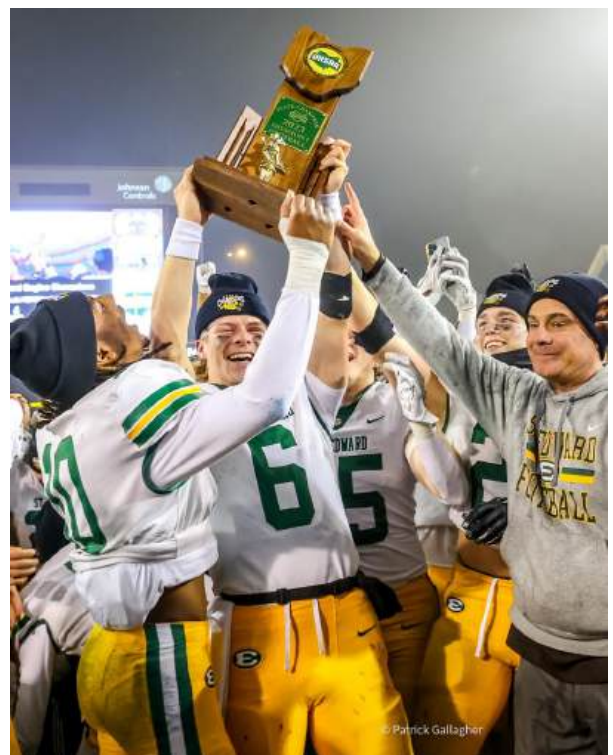

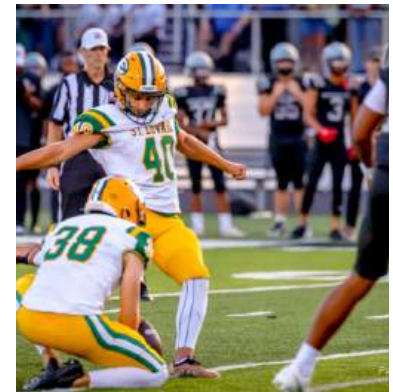
